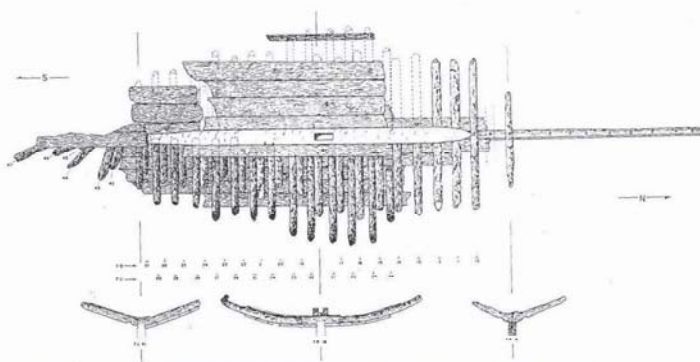


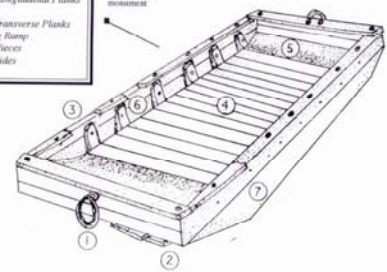

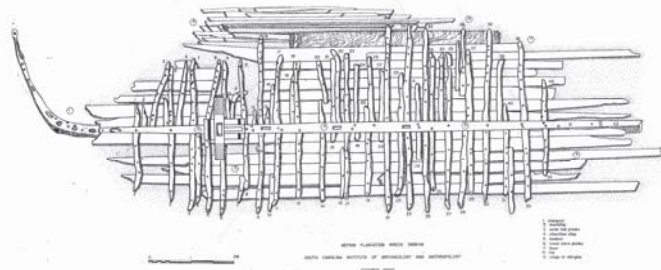


- 1. Towing Ring
